

## **Chief of Police City of Henderson, Nevada**

The City of Henderson, Nevada is currently conducting a national recruitment for the position of Chief of Police. Reporting to the City Manager, the Chief of Police will oversee a total staff of 627 staff (434 sworn) with an operating budget of approximately \$116.2 million. The ideal candidate will have excellent leadership and decision-making skills, and will be a person of integrity and unquestionable ethics. Top candidates will have experience successfully managing organizational change and advancing collaboratively-crafted, comprehensive reforms. This position requires a Bachelor's degree, FBI National Academy training or comparable executive-level law enforcement training, and fifteen years of progressively responsible law enforcement experience with five years of mid- to upper-level management experience. An equivalent combination of related training and experience may be considered. The annual salary range for this position is \$125,985 to \$193,823 plus an executive benefits package. The City of Henderson **does not** participate in Social Security except for the Medicare portion. Candidates should be aware that the State of Nevada has no personal income tax.
